At the Conference, there were presentations and discussions on project results achieved by project partners during the project implementation process. It has been noted that plastic waste separation was successfully introduced in Kutaisi, which actively involves the population of the city. The composting process is being actively implemented in Ararat. Composting has become popular with the population of Ararat. In Ungheni, sorted waste collection has become even more effective, and new approaches have been introduced.

One of the project components consisted of educational and informational activities for target groups and beneficiaries, including publications, trainings, and lessons for pupils, environmental events, and so on.
